As always, a wide range of classes is available to enter, including, for its second year, a canine fancy dress for everyone to enjoy – spectators and entrants (of however many legs) alike. Handlers can get well and truly into the fun by also dressing up but this entirely optional.

There's a new class for 2019 – class 9, Best travelling companion. This reflects the transport theme and can be interpreted widely – all canines from a miniature friend in a handbag to a St. Bernard carrying supplies of refreshments – and all in between!

Entries can be made for all classes from 10:00 am at Ring 2 in the school grounds - at £1 per class.

The fun dog show is always popular and, while we will do our best to have everyone take part, it may be necessary to limit the number of entries - so please enter as early in order to avoid disappointment.

Mirfield Show Fun Dog Show - 2019

RULES:

- 1) Entry to Mirfield Show classes costs £1 per class.
- 2) All entries are to be registered at the show desk, at the appropriate entry points by the dog ring, between 9:30 am and 15 minutes before the scheduled commencement of the class, subject to rule 3.
- 3) The organisers reserve the right to close entries to any class if they consider that the number of entries already registered has reached capacity.
- 4) Rosettes will be awarded to 6th place in each class.
- 5) All owners must take full responsibility for their dogs and their actions whilst attending Mirfield Agricultural Show.
- 6) All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and under proper control.
- 7) The judge, stewards or security staff may ask any owner to remove their dog from all areas where any aspect of the show is or will be taking place if they believe that the animal may pose a risk to themselves or others or if they believe the animal to be in ill health.
- 7) Mirfield Agricultural Show Society Limited, Society members, or any person relating to the Society cannot take any responsibility for any loss, injury or damage caused to people, animals or property whilst on the showground.
- 8) Owners must clean up after their dogs at all times during their visit to all show areas and to use the bins provided - failure to do so will result in automatic disqualification and dismissal from all classes.
- 9) The judge's decision is final.
- 10) The committee reserve the right to alter or amend the programme and to change the organisational and entry arrangements, as they see fit.
