



HORTICULTURE CLASSES 2023 – RULES

- 1) All entries are free
- 2) All exhibits to have been grown by the exhibitor
- 3) Staging in the marquee on the Showground from 7.30am to 9.45am on Show Day
- 4) Any exhibitor staging more or less than the number of vegetables or flowers specified in the relevant class will be disqualified
- 5) Entries to be received no later than 9.45am on Show Day
- 6) Judging to commence from 9.50am
- 7) The Show in the marquee will be open for viewing from 12 noon
- 8) Prizes (trophies/rosettes/medals) will be awarded/presented/available at 2.30pm in the marquee
- 9) Exhibits must not be removed before 4pm on Show Day (exhibits remaining at 5pm will be cleared)
- 10) The Agricultural Show Top Tray to consist of six different items, to be staged in an area 12" x 12" square
- 11) See the CLASSES DETAILS for more information about sizes of pots and displays
- 12) Novice classes are open to anyone who has not won a 1st or 2nd prize at any flower/vegetable show
- 13) The decision of the judge is final
- 14) The Committee reserves the right to alter the programme if necessary
